

## Summer Stretch 2012

### High School Leader Job Description

Summer Stretch is a program designed to meet a variety of objectives. First, for the Junior High participants it seeks to expose them to a variety of service opportunities and ministries as well as provide them an experience of fellowship within the faith community. Second, for the Senior High Leaders it is a chance for them to practice leadership skills, minister to others, and develop their spiritual gifts. Third, for the Summer Stretch Staff it provides experience being in an official position of leadership, ministry, authority, and teaching.

As a Summer Stretch High School Leader one is expected to:

- Be a positive role model in faith by leading small groups in Bible study, prayer, worship, service, and fellowship.
- Work alongside participants in service.
- Monitor behavior of participants.
- Represent Lord of Life positively in the community.
- Focus on the experience of youth participants.

Tasks include:

- Greeting youth as they arrive
- Participating with youth in singing and worship
- Leading Bible studies and discussion as outlined
- Leading the group during service projects
- Engaging with youth during service and recreation events and when traveling
- Make sure you know where your group members are
- Watch for and redirect inappropriate behavior
- Encourage and name positive behavior
- Report to staff any concerns or share any joys

Qualifications:

- Completed the tenth grade
- Completed Peer Ministry Training
- Strong personal faith in Jesus Christ and a commitment to the Lutheran Confessions
- Ability to demonstrate strong leadership skills
- Be a team player
- Have strong communication skills
- Be dependable
